

SIP (Cross-Ministerial Strategic Innovation Promotion Program)

- Aiming to realize Science, Technology and Innovation through promoting R&D overlooking from basic research to application and commercialization by crossministerial cooperation.
- CSTI defined the themes to solve societal issues and achieve economic growth
- CSTI appoints Program Directors (PDs) for each project and allocates the budget.
